If you would like to use the pickup points system in Australia, here's how it works.

1. Contact StarTrack Express and have them deliver your entries to the nearest depot.
2. Address the entries to the Victorian address, but send it via the local address.
3. Make sure you put **A/c 100 5297 on the Con Note.**
4. The local depot will send all the exhibits to Melbourne and then packaged entries will be delivered to Ballarat and the draught entries to the Showgrounds.
5. We will then calculate the costs based on your number of entries and invoice you.

NEW ZEALAND EXHIBITORS DELIVERY INSTRUCTIONS:

Entries from New Zealand can be sent to either the Ausprologistics address in Victoria, Australia, mentioned above or via our New Zealand collection point. If you wish to use the collection point then your Exhibits should be addressed and delivered as below. Exhibits may not be judged if received after the nominated delivery dates. We will then arrange to have the whole consignment shipped to us. We will calculate the costs based on your number of entries and invoice you.

USA EXHIBITORS DELIVERY INSTRUCTIONS:

Entries from the USA can be sent to either the Ausprologistics address in Victoria, Australia, mentioned above or via the Brewers Association collection point.

The Brewers Association has been assisting American brewers to enter the A.I.B.A. for many years. We have a good relationship with them and strongly recommend you contact them.

Here is some information from the Brewers Association:

“The American brewer must be a member of the Brewers Association and a member of the Export Development Program to be able to send their beers through us. The BA EDP pays for the first 3 entries of a member brewery's beers into the A.I.B.A. competition (they can enter as many beer brands as they want, but they pay for the 4th beer on up), the BA EDP also pays for shipping (from our warehouse to your judging location in Australia), customs fees, taxes, etc. So the cost to the member brewery is the beer and shipping to the Brewers Association warehouse.

Our program is only for Brewers Association members, who are also Export Development Program members. Here is the web address that details our program:
